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CONDITIONS OF BECOMING A FOSTER CARER

1. to house the animal in accommodation approved by the Society and properly care for it at all times.
2. to ensure that if I foster a dog it will at all times wears a collar with identification, and in the event of the dog being lost, I agree to inform the Police and the Society within 24 hours;
3. not to part with possession of the animal except to return it to the Society.
4. to permit an authorised member or official of the Society to visit my premises from time to time to be assured that the animal is happily settled and to verify the animal's welfare;
5. to exercise the dog on a regular basis;
6. not to chain the dog;
7. not to leave the dog without companionship for extended periods of time;
8. not to allow the dog out on the public highway unless on a lead or being exercised in an open space and keep under supervision;
9. to indemnify the Society against any loss or damage caused by the dog during the term of this fostering agreement.

Note: Failure to observe these conditions may result in the animal being removed by the GSPCA.

I am over 18 years of age. I have read and agree to abide by the above conditions of fostering and I understand that failure to comply with these terms automatically gives the Guernsey Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals the right to remove the animal from my care.
